REPORT ON FIRST AID SEMINAR

INTRODUCTION: The Aishabai college of Education NSS unit, as organized First aid seminar for student teachers. Emphasizing the importance of quick and effective response in emergence situation.

OBJECTIVE: The primary objectives of the seminar were to educate participants on the fundamental principles of first aid, equip them with practical skills to respond to common medical emergencies, and instill confidence in providing immediate assistance when needed.

1. Basic Life Support (BLS): Participants learned the ABCs of first aid—Airway, Breathing, and Circulation. Practical demonstrations and hands-on exercises were conducted to reinforce these foundational principles.
2. Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and AED Usage: Detailed instructions on administering CPR and utilizing Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) were provided. Participants had the opportunity to practice these skills.
3. Injury Management: The seminar delved into the assessment and management of various injuries, such as burns, fractures, sprains, and severe bleeding. Attendees gained insights into proper wound care and stabilization techniques.

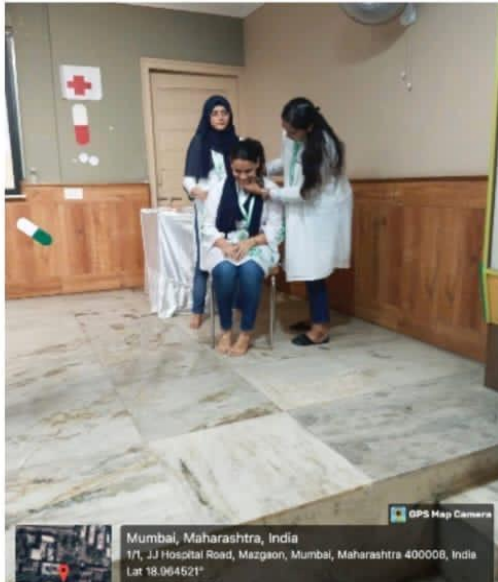

Description of Event

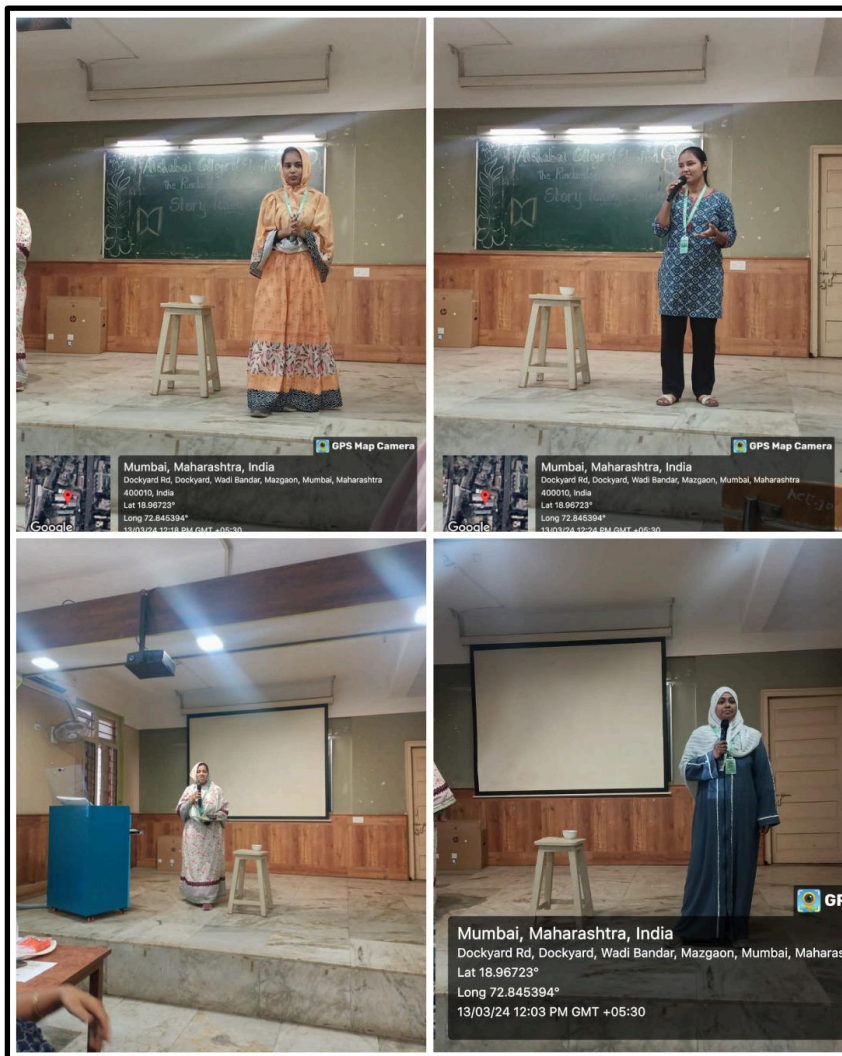
The competition followed an extempore format, where participants chose a prompt from a selection provided with a specific theme. The theme for this competition was Extempore Story Telling Competition.
