Keeping in mind the objectives of community outreach programs the college has planned many activities in the last five years. **Also the college has made MOU's with J.J. Shatabdi Municipal school and Fazlani trust school at Takway Lonavla.** The college organizes many activities with these two schools. Also the college conducts many activities at community level so that there should be continuous development in the students. With reference to this the following are activities that the college have conducted during last five years:

2019 – 2020

On 23rd April 2019 visit was done to Yusuf Meharoli center, Panvel. At this center the students participated in the cleanliness of the surrounding area of center. The center have small scale industry like pottery making, gardening and more. Students gained information about this industries as well as there was experties lecture on Gandhian movement during freedom.

On 5th June 2019, World Environment Day was celebrated by creating an awareness program on saving the environment. For this purpose the students prepared slogans and posters on environmental issues.

On 6th August 2019, a Health awareness program was organized. Medical camp on Thalassemia was run for the detection of thalassemia.

On 12th August 2019, the International Youth day Cleanliness drive was done on the college campus. Students were engaged in cleaning the classrooms, corridors, library, staff room, ground and more.

2020 -2021

As in the 2020 – 2021 year the whole world was suffering from Covid – 19 pandemic the college conducted all the activities online. 2021 – 2022
