> INTRODUCTION:

The Placement Cell at Aishabai College of Education, under the title "Empowering Futures: Educators' Odyssey - Campus Placement Drive," was established in the academic year 2023-2024, to equip our students with the necessary skills and opportunities to transition smoothly into the teaching profession. Under the leadership of Dr. Shumaila Patrawala Saif Siddiqui a Coordinator from staff, Ms. Madhuri Bendale, the Placement Cell officer was appointed for the academic year 2023-2024 and focused on bridging the gap between academic learning and practical employment. Under this Drive, many activities and events were planned. The Placement Cell was committed to providing a platform for aspiring educators to connect with potential employers and gain meaningful employment in the field of education.

> OBJECTIVES

- To equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in job interviews and professional settings.
- To create a bridge between educational institutions and schools, ensuring the right match between candidates and job opportunities.
- To organize innovative and engaging placement activities that prepare students for the dynamic requirements of the teaching profession.

> KEY ACTIVITIES AND INITIATIVES

Pre-Placement Training Workshops:

- Skill Development Sessions: Conducted online and offline workshops focusing on communication skills, interview techniques, and resume building.
- Mock Interviews: Organized mock interviews with experienced educators and school administrators to simulate real-life interview scenarios.

Career Guidance and Counselling:

- Regular one-on-one counselling sessions were conducted to help students identify their strengths, areas for improvement, and career goals.
- Guidance on choosing the right schools based on individual preferences and career aspirations.

Innovative Placement Drives:

CV Writing Workshop
